Rural Centres and Townships are distinct towns with a connection to the agricultural lands around them. They can vary in size and scale, and many have a low scale appearance with a strong heritage character.

They usually feature a central main street with formal planting and shops to service communities and industries. This typology also features other uses such as schools and civic buildings, as well as churches.


