

Toowoomba Design Framework

Phase 1 Consultation

The Toowoomba Design Framework for Towns and Suburbs is a study that will outline the community values which must be considered when looking at future planning developments in Toowoomba's regional communities.

It will protect the things we love most about our region and its towns. It will also identify how communities want their towns to adapt to meet their needs and those of future generations. The Framework forms part of Toowoomba Region Futures, a program designed to build a community vision for growth and change in our region for the next 30 years.

In March and April 2021 we invited the community to join a conversation as part of the Talking Towns survey to help us get to the heart of what makes our towns so great. We also asked you to tell us what can be improved and what we need to protect, including natural, cultural and man-made features that are important or culturally significant. Key findings from the Talking Towns feedback is outlined below.
